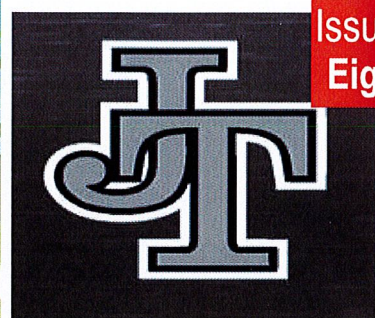

### **BOARD OF EDUCATION**

- Elementary Art/STEM Teacher

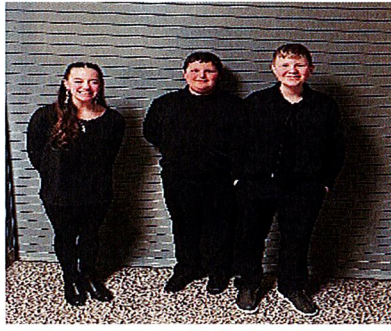

## High School News

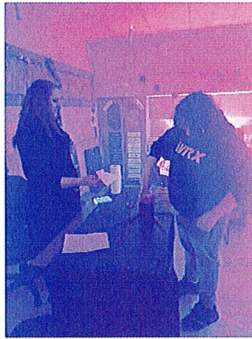
We've had a busy March here at the high school.

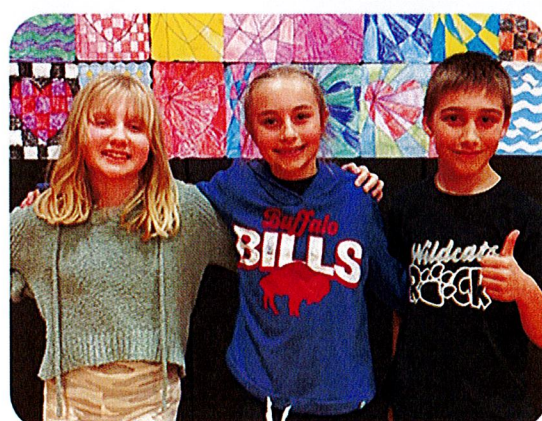
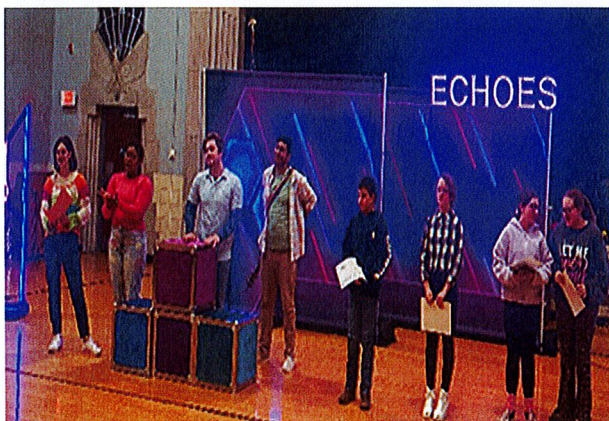




## Elementary News

Two of our sixth grade students were selected for All-County Band, and three of our sixth grade students were selected for All-County Chorus. 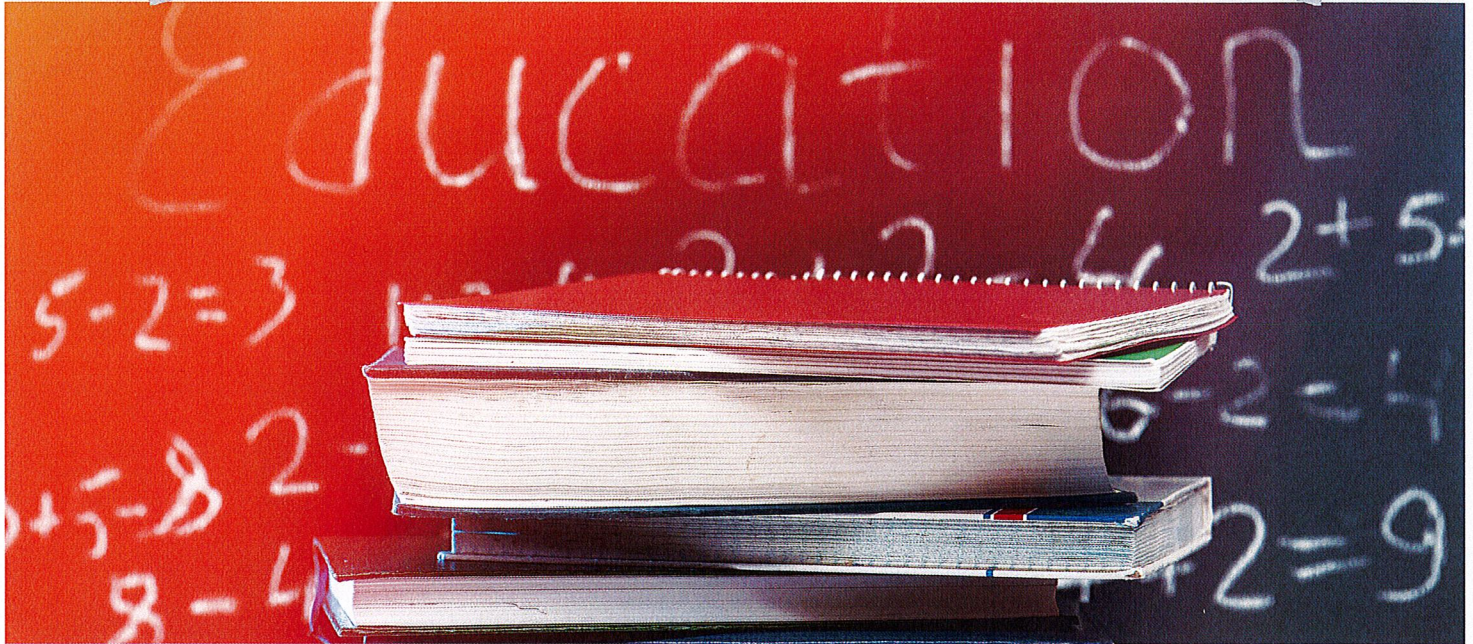

## **ELECTION TELLERS NEEDED**

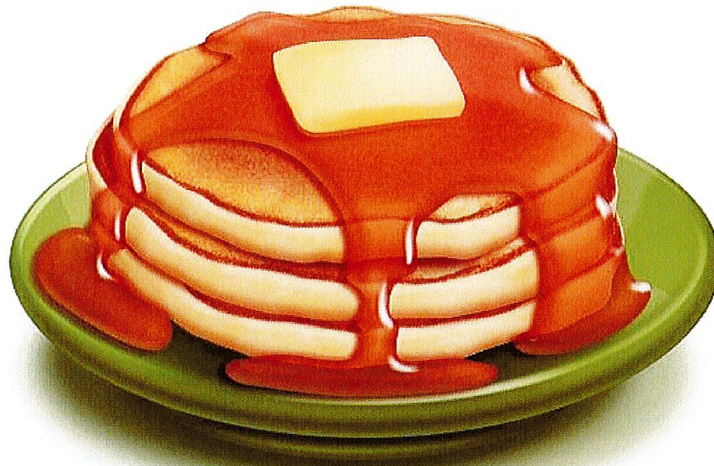
