Budget Presentations

The District Office and Board of Education are preparing the 2023 -2024 budget. Budget presentations will occur at the March BOE meetings during the development process. Other important budget related dates are below:

BOARD OF EDUCATION

The Jasper-Troupsburg Board of Education will have one vacancy beginning in the 2023-2024 school year. This seat will be on the ballot at the May 16, 2023 budget vote.

To run for a seat on the BOE, a person must be 18 years of age, a resident of the Jasper-Troupsburg Central School District, and have a completed signed petition on file by **April 17, 2023**.

Professional Development

As always, an important District focus is professional development for our faculty and staff. The upcoming March 20th Superintendent's Conference Day will feature various professional development sessions specific to each role. The keynote speaker for the conference day is Steve Spangler, a STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math) educator and television personality who will kick-off the event with his presentation surrounding student engagement and experiences. Mr. Spangler will continue to work with teachers who are responsible for Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math instruction and our teacher aides for the remainder of the day. Teachers who are responsible for content not specific to STEM will be participating in sessions such as Strengthening Student Writing, Innovative Activities for Strengthening the PE Program, and multiple art, music, and Spanish offerings. Our nurses, guidance counselors, and speech and occupational therapists will benefit from trainings that further enhance their toolkits of strategies and practices. Our drivers and maintenance staff will also be participating in trainings regarding safety and topics of required compliance.

We are very fortunate that our ESSA Title II funding is adequate to cover our professional development needs. Using this funding, we are able to provide every faculty and staff member with a day of learning that will benefit our students directly.


