

FEMA UPDATES

April brought very few changes to the projects that are in the FEMA process. Detailed information about each of the projects can be found on the district website.

At this time, we are still waiting for FEMA to review estimates and determine if the district has met the 50% Rule calculation. This calculation will determine if the district qualifies for a replacement building or if we will be renovating the existing building. If the cost of renovating the damaged building is more than 50% of the cost of replacing the building, then FEMA will allow a replacement.

Another aspect of the process is obtaining and maintaining flood insurance for the building. This has presented many difficulties because the building is not in a flood zone and because we do not have a decision from FEMA yet as to whether the building will be renovated or replaced.

The building, the contents of the building, the track and multi-purpose court, and the parking lots are all what FEMA considers "large projects" because they are valued at over \$1,000,000 each. With a large project, the funds are acquired through a reimbursement process. This means that when a large project makes it through the full FEMA process, the district will need to submit for progress payments as work is completed.

Projects less than \$1,000,000 are obligated in full once they make it through the full FEMA process. So far, the district has only received funds to pay for the Emergency Work completed by ServPro and Steuben County for disposal of flood debris, and for the upcoming work at the baseball and softball fields and dugouts.

High School News

The month of March ended at the high school with a spectacular music concert directed by Mr. Avnet featuring the Junior and Senior High Chorus and Band along with the Jazz Band. A great deal of practice and hard work was showcased by the students. It was a wonderful event enjoyed by all.

April is in full swing with several activities and highlights. Logan was featured as the Wildwood BOCES Student of the Month for Welding and Metal Fabrication. Congratulations Logan!

Mr. Ford's 11th grade English classes held a Town Hall style debate where the students presented their information, fielded questions from the audience and discussed their topics with the hopes of swaying the audience in their direction. This was a great opportunity for the students to showcase their ability to answer questions, without prior knowledge of the question, while being respectful and understanding of the opinions of others in a public meeting setting.

Members of FFA participated in Sub States competition this month. Four members of the Junior High Tool Identification team placed and two members of the Ag Mechanical team placed 3rd and 4th. The Ag Mechanical team, consisting of Brent, Colten, Cole, and Josh then went on to compete at the State Championship in Cobleskill.

The seventh and eighth graders completed the NYS ELA exam the week of the April 17^{th} and the NYS Math exam will be taking place on May 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} . Also, the eighth grade Science Performance exam will be given May 30^{th} .


