Smart Schools Bond Act Project

The Smart Schools Bond Act will bring some needed changes to the Elementary Building. The proposed project includes updated networking, two new server closets for increased networking speed, and a secure vestibule and upgraded main en-

trance. The \$700,000 project is at no cost to tax payers, as the improvements are federally funded.



NYSERDA Energy Study

As part of the Clean Green Schools Initiative, the district participated in an energy study conducted by LaBella. The study was fully funded in track one of the initiative, and resulted in incredible potential cost saving measures while also reducing our carbon emissions by 261 Metric Tons each year. The next track of the project will allow schools to install energy saving measures, fully funded by NYSERDA.



FEMA UPDATES

Weekly virtual meetings with FEMA continue to take place every Wednesday. To date, funding to replace the baseball and softball dugouts and to resurface the baseball and softball fields has been allocated. FEMA projects to replace the track and multi-purpose court that was behind the high school, the high school parking lot, and the high school culverts and basins are still being reviewed by FEMA. Also still under FEMA review are the projects for the contents of the building and the building itself. At this time, everything on the district's end has been completed. While waiting for new information about these projects is certainly hard, we continue to be grateful that we have the Greenwood building to use as long as we need it.

CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

After several revisions following the flood, the Capital Improvement Project is ready for public consideration. The project features the addition of a large parking lot at the elementary that will allow for a dedicated car loop for student drop-off and pick-up. The proposed parking lot will be located next to the PreK parking lot, on district owned property. This eliminates the need for the previously discussed bus loop addition and allows the front lawn of the building to remain untouched.

High School News

November 4th was the end of the first marking period at the high school. 



WHAT ARE FINE MOTOR COORDINATION & VISUAL MOTOR INTEGRATION SKILLS?

<u>FINE MOTOR SKILLS</u>: Involve the use of precise and coordinated movements of the fingers and hands.

<u>VISUAL MOTOR INTEGRATION</u>: Is the coordination of hand movements based upon the perception of visual information. It is the execution of hand movements guided by what the child is seeing.

>>> <u>TOOL USE</u>: This is an age appropriate ability to grasp, hold, and release classroom tools (pencils, scissors, rulers, erasers) and manipulate school objects (paper, books). A student needs adequate strength, control, dexterity, and visual monitoring for success in this area.

- ACADEMIC IMPACT: A typical school day requires nearly ongoing use of a student's hands for performing school related activities. Intact fine motor skills will have a significant positive impact on a child's academic and functional success at school.
- >>> <u>DRAWING/PRE WRITING</u>: Drawing Skills involve the use of a tool (pencil, crayon, marker, pen, or chalk) to create a two dimensional picture, design, or image on a surface. The drawing may represent a person, animal, place, or object. Through drawings a child can share information from their mind. This is unique to humans.
- Pre-Writing skills involve a child tracing and forming proper strokes in the correct sequence and orientation for future printing.
 - ACADEMIC IMPACT: The ability to form vertical, horizontal, and diagonal, lines is an essential foundation skill for the future development of printing. The ability to draw is one measure of child's cognitive status; drawing is an important part of the academic curriculum.

HANDWRITING: is a complex process of recording language by hand, often by using paper and a pen or pencil. The production of legible and efficient handwriting requires intact skills in the areas of postural control, eye hand coordination, visual perception, fine motor control, ocular control, and pencil grasp.

<u>ACADEMIC IMPACT</u>: A child's handwriting abilities have significant influence on their academic performance.
