## ***Introduction***

In 1987, a public school merger created the Jasper-Troupsburg Central School. The school is accredited and registered by the New York State Board of Regents. We are located in a rural community in the Southern Tier of New York, with close proximity to Corning, NY. Our local economy is strongly supported by the agriculture industry.

## ***Grade Point Average & Class Rank***

G. P. A. is an unweighted calculation based upon final grades from grades 9-12, as well as any credit-bearing courses taken in 8<sup>th</sup> grade. All courses for which a student receives a grade are included in the grade point average.

Class Rank is a *weighted* calculation. Our weighting method uses the unweighted academic average as the base, and adds points for college level courses or select upper level high school courses. Rank is computed at the beginning of the senior year and at the end of the 30 week marking period during the senior year. The latter class rank is used on the final transcript.
