On March 8 and 9, Disney's *The Little Mermaid* comes to the stage at Jasper-Troupsburg Central High School. The action for the play is set below the waves in Triton's kingdom, on board Eric's ship and in the castle of Eric's father.

Under the leadership of Mr. Darren Litz and Mrs. Amy Stephens, the cast of *TLM* has been hard at work learning music, choreography, and lines. Playing the lead roles of Prince Eric and Ariel are Noah Price and Logan Foster. The antagonists are Ursula, played by Lizzy Flint, and the eels Flotsam and Jetsam, played by Lauren Ross and Makensy Welch. Eric's crew consists of Grimsby (Caleb Mills), Pilot (Colby Cornish), and the sailors (Bryce Myers, Hunter Heck, and Cayden Lawson). Other landlubbers include the madman of the kitchen, Chef Louis (Hunter Heck), and the princesses: Kiersten Foster, Kathryn Groff, Megan Ross, Stephanie Ebner, Taryn Hayes, and Kelsey Stellitano (watch for these ladies to reappear as the Mersisters in Act II). Bridging sky and sea are the Ocean Waves, played by Jillian Miles, Carley Sykora, Cash Perry, and Erica Carl. These busy girls will also appear as the maids on land. Crazy Scuttle, played by Haley Northrup, wings above the Waves. Under the sea will appear King Triton (Colton Foster), Flounder (Madison Herold), Sebastian (Leland Essigmann) and the Seahorse (Cayden Lawson). Joining the merpeople will be Wynter Hayes and members of the elementary chorus as sea and pond creatures.

Kathryn Groff is choreographing the show, while Mr. Litz's theater students are designing and painting the sets for the performance.

Performances are 7:30 PM, Friday, March 8, and 2:30 PM, Saturday, March 9. Tickets are available at the Jasper-Troupsburg High School main office (792-3690). Adult tickets are \$10; student tickets are \$7.
