

### **Student Expectations:**

- On remote learning days, whether in the hybrid model or virtual, students are expected to log on for attendance. In the hybrid model student must log on for attendance on the days they are home. If in a virtual model the student logs on Monday-Friday for attendance.
- Students are expected to log on to whatever format the teacher is using and participate in their learning throughout their normal daily schedule. Do not be out in public during a school day unless you have a medical appointment.
- Students are to engage in every lesson and complete all assignments in a timely manner as indicated by the teacher.
- If a student is having challenges with their school-issued device or internet, please reach out to the teacher immediately and let him/her know.
- If you do not have internet at home, please let your teacher know so that they may provide an alternate source of internet or instructional paper packets.
- If a student is having any difficulty or has questions, please reach out to your teacher between the hours of 8:25-3:20 so he/she may assist you.  
Please refrain from reaching out to teachers before or after school hours.

For clarification...all high school students need to follow the schedule that the school is currently using.
