

PreK-12 student, teacher or staff member with proof of full vaccination is exposed to COVID-19. (August 30, 2021)



Individual has no symptoms.

Individual has a temperature >100° OR develops new symptoms of COVID-19:

- Fever, chills
- Shortness of breath
- Sore throat
- Loss of taste or smell
- Headache
- Cough
- Nasal congestion
- Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches

Individual can remain in school as long as no symptoms develop.
AND
Individual wears a mask for 14 days from date of exposure per CDC guidance.

Highly recommended: Get a PCR COVID test 3-5 days after exposure per CDC guidance.



Individual is placed in quarantine by SCPH.

COVID-19 test result is positive:
Individual remains in isolation for 10 days from date of test.



Individual is released from isolation by SCPH.
INDIVIDUAL CAN RETURN TO SCHOOL.



COVID-19 test result is negative or NO test is completed: Individual remains in quarantine for 14 days and can return to school when released from quarantine by SCPH.
