

Jasper-Troupsburg Emergency Feeding Information

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, state and federal regulations allow districts to provide meals to children in need during school closures. The following guidance is how meals will be distributed in our area.

What is the schedule for meal site?

We are currently planning for two meals sites starting Thursday March 19th.

Meals will be provided weekdays

How do I Find Information?

Our School district website will have updated information. It may be updated daily based on current events. We advise you to check it daily before coming to a meal site for the latest information.

Who can get a meal?

Meals are available for those 18 years old or younger at no charge.

What will be served?

Meal sites will provide one (1) breakfast and (1) lunch per student. The menu items will follow the typical meal pattern with grain, protein, fruit and/or vegetable, milk. For those familiar with the Summer Food Service Program, the meals will be very similar.

Examples include PBJ sandwiches or yogurt and string cheese, assorted fruit, and other items.

Menus will likely not be posted on the website.

How will Meals be served? Will there be a dining area?

Depending on location meals will be provided via drive up or walk up service. The meals will be to-go and provided for recipients to take home and consume. There will not be a dining area.

What should I do if I'm having trouble getting to a site for meals?

Care has been taken with planning to provide reasonable access. In the event you are unable to access meals you need, please contact the school district.
